MINUTES OF XII - GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING

Welcome address:

Dr.C.Kanagaraj welcomed the honourable members of the governing Council and invited Dr.P.Kanagasabapathy, Chairman of the Governing Council to take over the proceedings.

Chairman Address:

The Chairman, Dr.P. Kanagasabapathy, began the proceedings by asking the CEO and Dr.T. Bina, Principal to brief the members about the development during the covid-19 pandemic and subsequent lockdown periods.

Dr.C. Kanagaraj explained the difficulties faced by the Institution with respect to admissions and academics. The CEO and the Principal had taken away the fear of job and salary cuts through many online meetings and kept the morale of teaching & non-teaching staff members high. Further he explained that nobody was removed from service and everyone was paid full salary for the entire period of pandemic.

Dr.T.Bina elaborated on how the academic activities were carried out with the help of ICT and about frequent assurance given to the students about syllabus coverage. She went on to explain how the online examinations were conducted and the excellent performance of the students.

The Chairman and members of the Governing Council applauded the CEO and the Principal Dr.T.Bina for coming out unscathed during the pandemic period.

Proceedings of the meeting:

1. Admissions

It was reviewed by the members and accepted that there was a dip in 2020-21 admissions due to covid-19. Many students from other states pulled out from the programme fearing the prolonged lockdown and uncertainty in the academic environment. The members were happy to note that the admission for the academic year 2021 - 22 was completed.



2. Placements

Dr.P.R. Muthuswamy, enquired about placement activities, and was briefed by the Principal.

The good placement record was appreciated by the members present.

3. MoUs

Shri. Omkar V Sankar enquired about signing of MoUs with industrial bodies. It was informed to the members that Happy Valley Business School signed an MoU with LUB (Laghu Udyog Bharath) on 15th September 2020. All the members appreciated the initiation and welcomed such developments for the benefit of the teachers and students.

4. Institute Social Responsibility

Shri.Rajiv Ramasamy and Shri.R. Ramkutty put forward a suggestion to take up local industrial visits as part of the research activities and to suggest possible solutions to the problems confronted by the industries especially MSMEs of Coimbatore.

5. Industry Connect


CA.Shri.G.Karthikeyan put forward a suggestion of conducting MDP programmes for the local industries and it was endorsed by all the members.

Based on the points discussed, it was resolved that the following points are needed to be part of the new strategic plan for action.


- 1. Faculty interaction with industry, especially, new age companies.



MINUTES OF XI - GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING

Governing council meeting of Happy Valley Business School for the academic year 2019 – 2020 was held on 26th February 2020 at 11.00 am in the Board Room of Hotel Vivanta by Taj, Coimbatore. The members present were:

Welcome Address:

The CEO Dr.C.Kanagaraj welcomed all to the Governing Council meeting. The new members to the Governing Council were introduced to the other members. The CEO elaborated on the important developments during the year to all members which included II MBA Students securing paid internships, successful placement offers from reputed corporates like EY and Northern Trust, Outreach programs to UG Colleges and signing of International MoU's. The CEO then requested the Chairman of the meeting Dr. Kanagasabapathy to take over the proceedings.

Chairman Address

The Chairman Dr. Kanagasabapathy began the proceedings and facilitated a discussion based on the agenda of the meeting circulated. The following were the salient points discussed / proceedings related to the year 2018 -19:

11.1 Report of the action taken on the decisions of the Governing Council held on June 30, 2018.

The Governing Council noted the action taken on the decisions of the meeting of the previous Governing Council



11.2 Review of Admissions:

Review of admissions for the academic year was done. The members noted the point that despite the general slowdown in MBA admissions in and around the city Happy Valley has been able to attract the requisite number of students.

11.3 Review of Results:

The results of the academic year were reviewed and the members noted the academic preparation by the B-School.

11.4 Review of Placements

Placement efforts taken by the Placement Cell were reviewed. The council members were appreciative of the number of placements and the increase in the year-on-year figures.

11.5 Review of NBA Accreditation Preparation

The Council reviewed the progress of NBA Accreditation work. The need for a quality certification was once again felt highly desirable by all the members. The members stressed that the NBA accreditation would be an endorsement to the efforts of all parties involved. They noted that the NBA accreditation team visit is scheduled in March 2020.

11.6 Review of MoU's

A review of MoU's during the year was made. The members noted the MoU signed with Lincoln University Malaysia and took cognizance of the other MoU in progress with Asia Pacific University, Malaysia. The members were interested to learn of the Student / Faculty exchange and Certificate Program possibilities due to the MoU.

11.7 Promotional Activities

The promotional activities planned for the year was discussed. The members noted that in addition to the usual activities arrangements with Shiksha.com and College Dekho have been made. The members felt this was necessary to increase the diversity of the student days as this would give a cross cultural exposure to MBA students.



11.8 Closure of Master of Applied Management Course

The members noted the decision of Happy Valley Business School to close the Master of Applied Management Course. The Course was being discontinued as it faced operational constraints and the curriculum was not on the lines of what Happy Valley B-School expected it to be prior to its application for the course.

11.9 Faculty / Student Developments

The members also reviewed the developments related to faculty interactions with outside colleges and students participation in various forums. The members were happy with the visits being made by faculty to other colleges across Tamilnadu and Kerala and also with the active interest of students in becoming members of associations like Confederation of Indian Industries (CII) and Young Indians (YI) year after year. This year the students have come forward to become members of The Rotaract club.

11.10 Strategic Plans

The Governing Council members also discussed the Strategic Plans for the future and envisaged the progress of the B-School. A need to structure and devise new programs was unanimously felt by all members concerned and it was decided to initiate work in this regard.

Chairman elaborated on the New Education Policy and mooted the idea of practical Apprenticeship programs being offered during the tenure of the course. He spoke on the developments in Government policy that will be supportive of such endeavours. Also he mooted the idea of establishing resource centre to do field research and conduct field and single- industry studies.

Following the Chairman's deliberations various members presented their views on the above discussed points as summarized below:

Dr.P.R.Muthuswamy, Member, Governing Council stressed the need to offer certification programs designed / developed by Happy Valley Business School. He indicated areas like Business Analytics as emerging areas. He also suggested looking at Fintech Models to be emulated by students.



C.A. Shri. G.Karthikeyan, Member, Governing Council congratulated the team for weathering the challenging environment. He proposed the idea of online based courses which are to receive Government support in near future. He proposed considering vertical and horizontal expansion to augment further growth of the B-School.

Shri. R.Ramkutty, Member, Governing Council expressed his desire to encourage more students to take up entrepreneurship. He being an entrepreneur, he advised the B-School to address risk-taking ability of the students.

Shri. Omkar V Sankar, Member, Governing Council recalled his days of BITS PILANI and supported the idea of certification courses. He proposed offering certificate courses to the broader market. He suggested deputing students for real-time events conducted by organizations like CREDAI to get them exposed to funds raising, planning and executing the event so as to instill a sense of ownership and remove the risk of failure.

Shri. Rajiv Ramaswamy, Member, Governing Council spoke at length about the present state of management education and felt there was a need to revisit the value addition dimension. He proposed that B-School should endeavor to create an intrapreneurial mindset among students that would help them become better employees or job creators. He proposed the idea of B-Schools taking up the task of managing "business-silos" within a home-based industry that would help them learn on-the-job. He also proposed offering programs on the lines of Executive MBA of shorter durations. He highlighted the need to educate students in the area of Rural Marketing.

Dr.C.Kanagaraj, Member, Governing Council thanked the members for the multitude of ideas and responded with the activities being pursued currently on the practical apprenticeship and certificate programs. He promised to draft an action plan.

Dr.T.Bina, Member, Governing Council thanked the members and promised to integrate possible ideas to the curriculum and come out with a roadmap soon.

Based on the points discussed it was resolved that the following activities be pursued for the year in progress.

- 1. Design Certification courses for Industry
- 2. Propagate Entrepreneurship to students.
- 3. Augment Industry association (CREDAI and TIE)

The CEO proposed the Vote of Thanks and the Chairman adjourned the meeting sine die.
